All class tuitions do not include dance outfits, costumes, props, rental fees, text books, recording music, painting tools, etc..

(open) - the class open to returning and new students to join. The first week class is for new student to try out.

(closed) - means the class standard has already reached a certain level, and is only for current students to register. If the new student would like to join, please consult CCAI's teacher for placement try out.

All adult dance classes are recreational, not require to perform, if students wish to perform the new dance, you must register two classes: the regular class and the other Dance Performance class (need 4 pelope to open).

For Chinese Drama class: open for the student would like to learn theater performance, but needs to have basic understanding mandarin with speaking/ listening ability in order to join the class.

Private Lesson Policy: the lesson focuses on a single student and charged by hour and per student. Also the student has no duty to perform for this class. Private lesson provides subject: Chinese dance, on line Er-hu/ vilion/ viola music, painting/calligraphy, Chinese language, ballet. Must take weekly.

If the student requests a special program to perform for CCAI's Gala performance, there are 2 basic conditions: 1. the student must take weekly private lessons and the program must meet performance quality. 2.The student must pre-sell 30 or more tickets (Cannot combine purchasing tickets with other CCAI's families).
